Simple Machines Matching Memory Game

Instructions for printing and assembly:

Print game cards. They will work best on card stock, and last longer laminated. Cut out each individual card.

To play: Turn cards face down and take turns matching the objects to the type of machine they are. When you make a match, keep the cards. When you don't match turn the cards back over in the same spots. The player with the most matches at the end of the game wins.

Please note: There are two compound machines, scissors (wedge and lever) and wheelbarrow (lever and wheel and axel). If this is too complex at first just remove those 4 cards when first playing.




